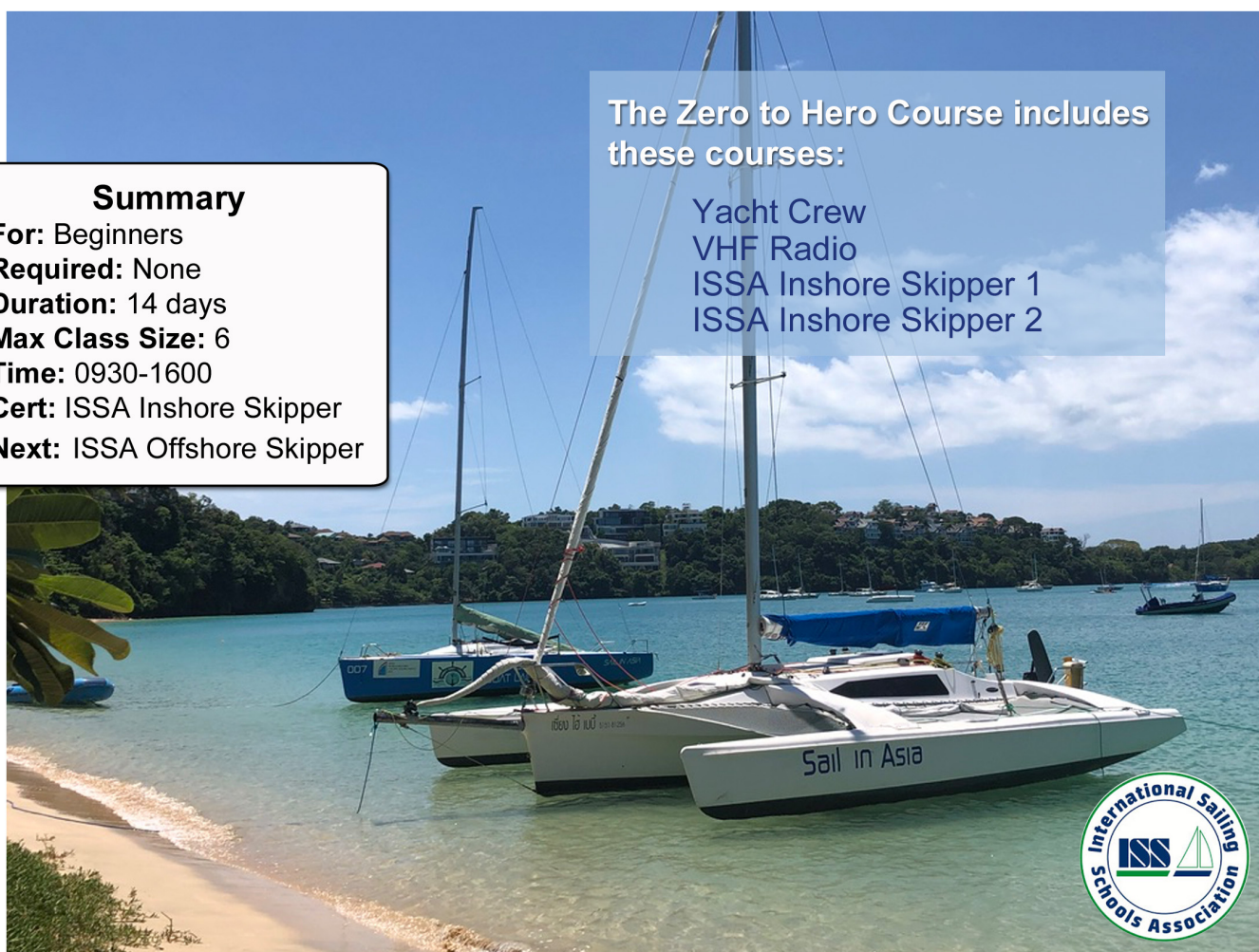

- 7 Inshore Skipper 1 - theory, IRPCS, buoyage,
- 8 Inshore Skipper 1 - practical navigation
- 9 Inshore Skipper 2 - practical boat handling
- 10 Inshore Skipper 2 - theory, passage planning, engines
- 11 Inshore Skipper 2 - theory, navigation, lights
- 12 Inshore Skipper 2 - practical, navigation, boat handling
- 13 Inshore Skipper 2 - practical, anchor, mooring, sail trim
- 14 Inshore Skipper 2 - practical, final assessment.

You will earn an ISSA Inshore Skipper Certificate and an ISSA VHF Operator's certificate.

Certificate Limitations

- Command of a vessel up to a maximum length of 24m / 78ft
- Up to 20 miles offshore
- In daylight hours
- In fair conditions with moderate wind and sea conditions

This certificate is the level of competence needed when chartering a boat where there is a restricted cruising area and the vessel has to be safely moored in a marina or anchored before dark.
